

CITIZENS POLICE ACADEMY

The Citizens Police Academy is a 10-week course designed to educate the community about police protocol and procedure. The classes are taught by police officers and provide citizens an inside view of the daily activities of the Georgetown Police Department. Classes are scheduled for Thursday nights. Sessions start promptly at 6:00 p.m. and end at 8:00 p.m. Most of the classes are held in the training room of the Public Safety Operations and Training Center (PSOTC), 3500 D. B. Wood Road, Georgetown, TX. Some classes may be held off site.

In past CPA courses, the classes have included topics such as Calling 911, Emergency Response Team (ERT/SWAT) Responses, Texas DPS, Texas Rangers, Williamson County Sheriff's Office K-9, Interview and Interrogation, Warrants/Municipal and Teen Courts, District and County Courts and Magistrates, Juvenile Justice, Georgetown Police Honor Guard, Hostage Negotiations, and Crime Scene Investigations.
