

Weather Sirens

Outdoor Warning System:

These sirens are an outdoor warning system. They are intended to alert people “outdoors” to severe weather conditions. The sirens are not intended to alert people that are inside a structure. A weather alert radio can be a useful tool for that purpose. Families can purchase a weather alert radio as an additional resource for emergency preparedness.

The outdoor sounding sirens are your cue to listen to your local radio and/or television for information concerning severe weather in the area. You must make an informed decision on your safety and the safety of your family and take immediate action. **DO NOT** call 9-1-1 to ask for weather information.

Why Do the Weather Sirens Go Off At Noon Every Wednesday?

It is a weekly test of the sirens to see that they are in proper working order. The test is typically short in duration. If it continues to sound for over 5 minutes, then it is not a test but an actual warning.
